

Introduction

Westmeath County Council (WCC) in conjunction with Transport Infrastructure Ireland (TII) intends to deliver a greenway from Kilbeggan to Mullingar. This section of greenway will complete a strategic link between the established greenway infrastructure, which is part of the Galway to Dublin national cycleway, at Mullingar and the greenway infrastructure at Kilbeggan, which links onto the Grand Canal greenway. This will provide a high-quality greenway, designed to promote cycling, walking and other non-motorised travel.

Work began on this project in 2021 by Offaly County Council (OCC) but was not completed due to changes in the guidelines for delivery of greenway projects. TII are now the Funding and Approving Authority for the project. The project is now being delivered on a phased basis in accordance with the TII's Project Manager's Manual for Greenway Projects.

In 2023, WCC appointed Consultants RPS to deliver the proposed greenway through Phases 1 to 4 of the TII Guidelines. We are now at the initial Phase 1 Public Consultation stage of project development, which is focused on the Study Area and the Constraints. We have identified the broad project study area (see map overleaf) within which the greenway could feasibly be located; and the likely constraints that could impact where and how the greenway is designed.

Members of the public and interested parties are invited to participate in the public consultation phase. The purpose of this first public consultation is to present the Study Area, identify Constraints and hear your feedback.

- Locations, attractions, or facilities in your locality that could be attractive to greenway users or would benefit from a Greenway
- Constraints or barriers to a greenway in your area






