Introduction

Westmeath County Council (WCC) in conjunction with Transport Infrastructure Ireland (TII) intends to deliver a greenway from Kilbeggan to Mullingar. This section of greenway will complete a strategic link between the established greenway infrastructure, which is part of the Galway to Dublin national cycleway, at Mullingar and the greenway infrastructure at Kilbeggan, which links onto the Grand Canal greenway. This will provide a high-quality greenway, designed to promote cycling, walking and other non-motorised travel.

Local Communities, Interest Groups and local businesses all stand to benefit from the opportunities that come with the proposed Greenway.

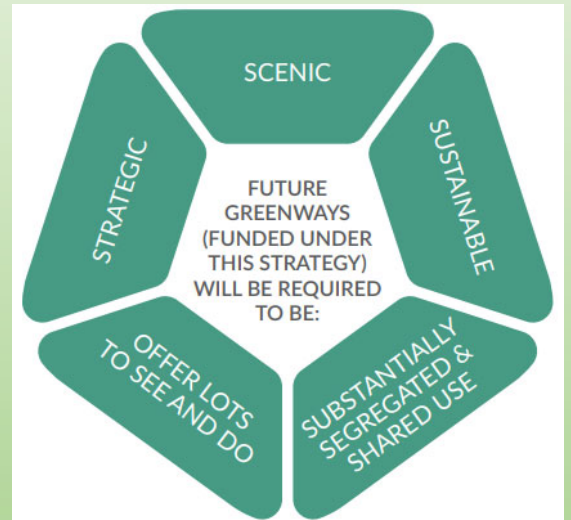

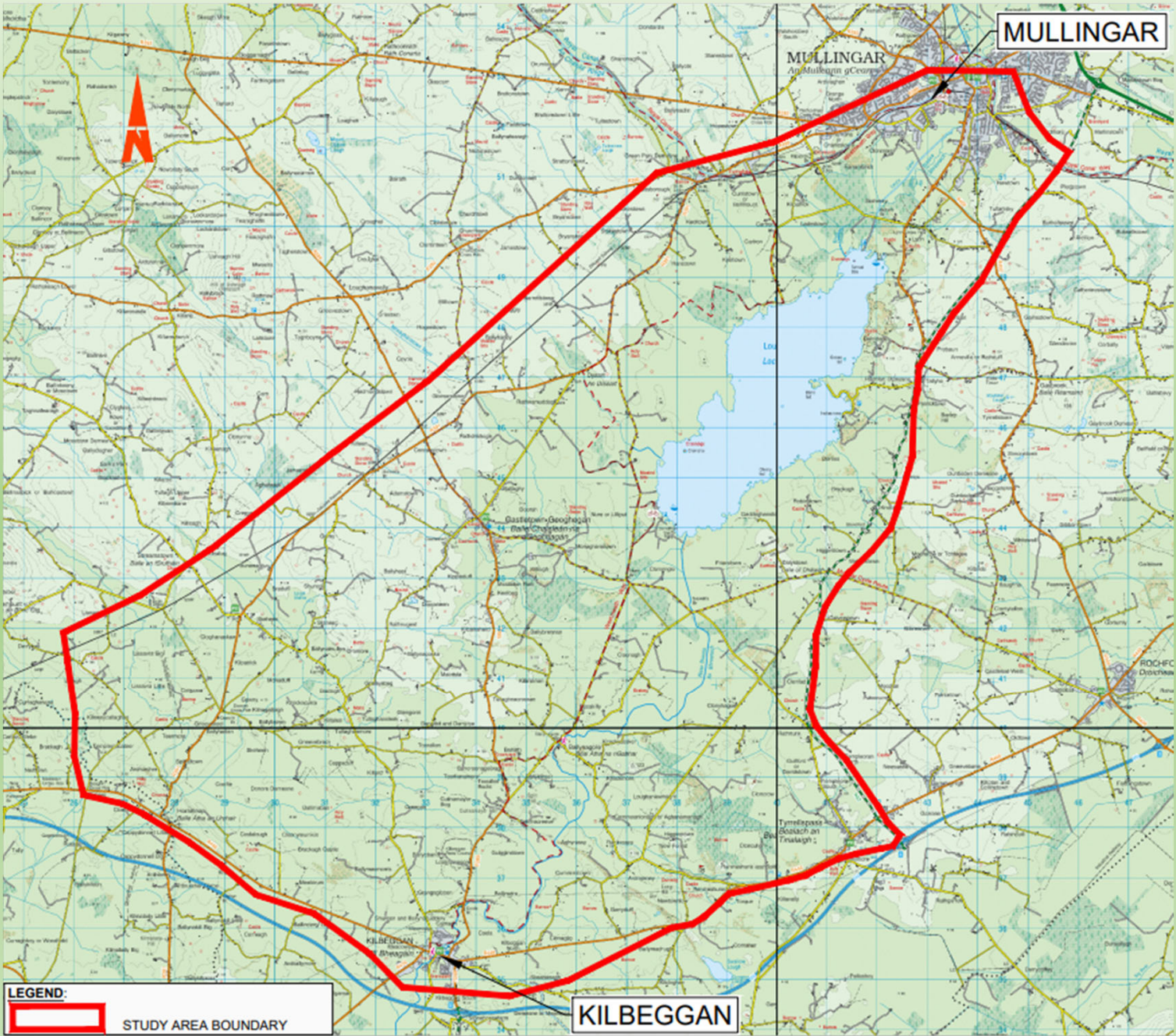

Study Area

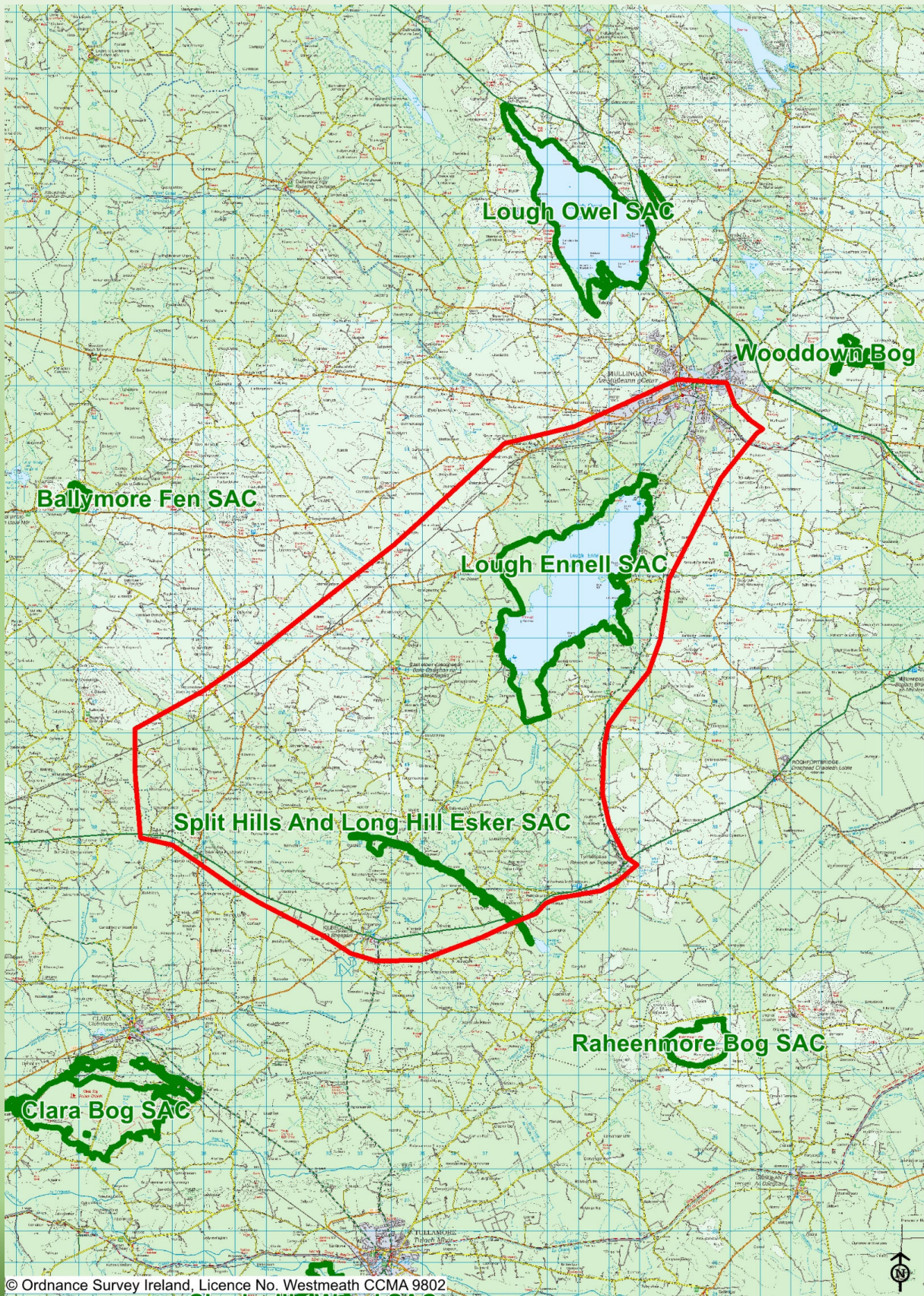




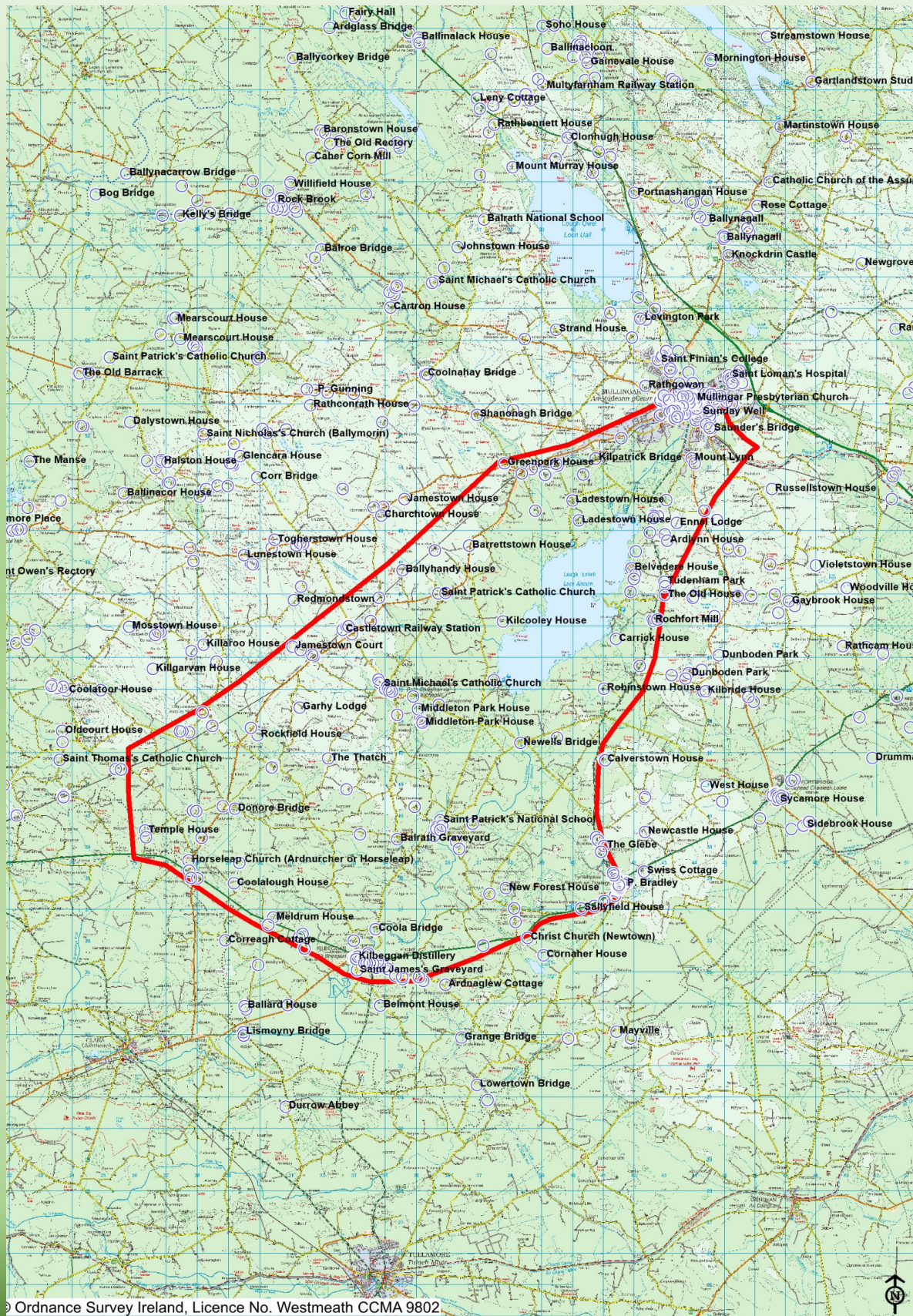

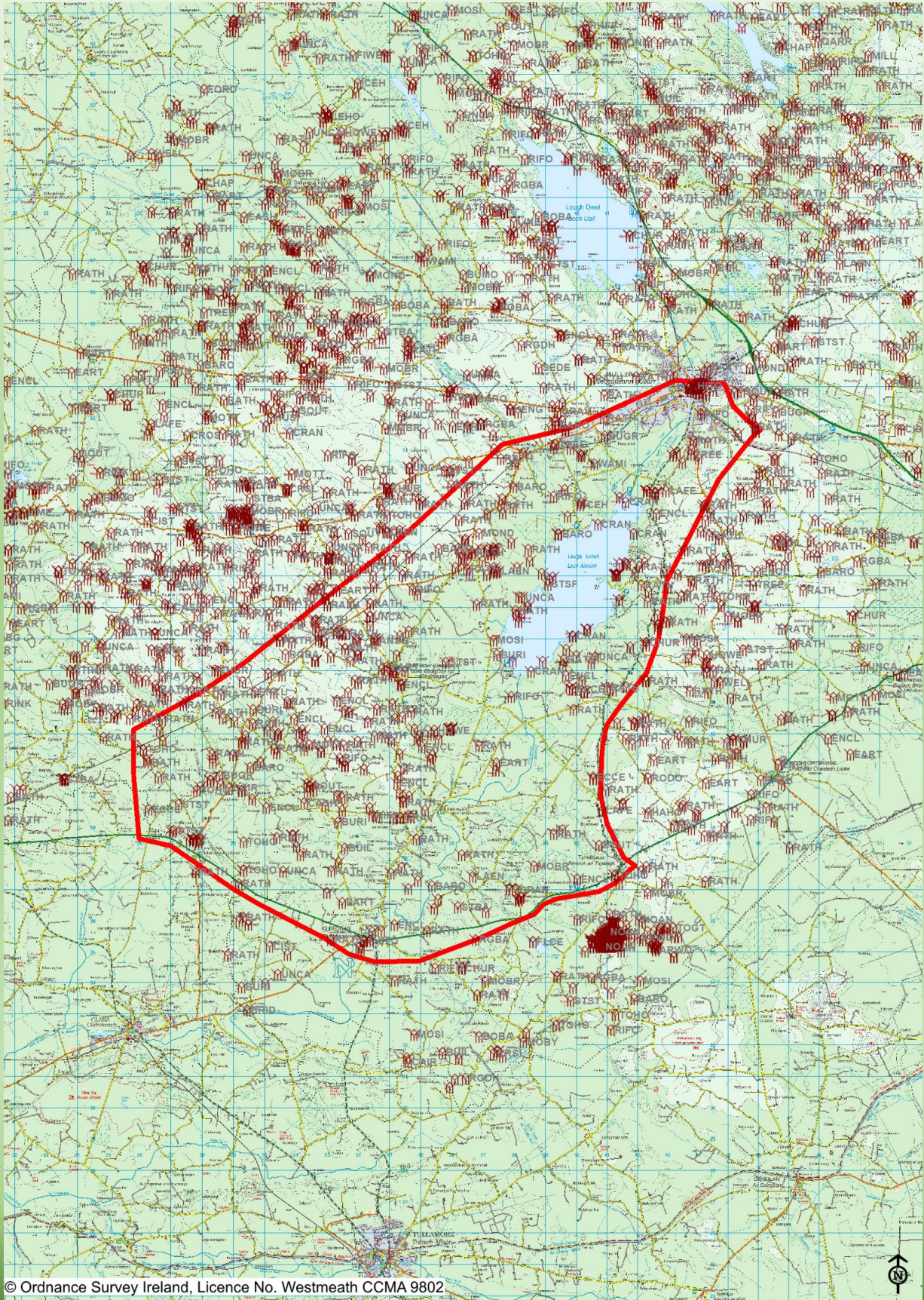
Known Key Environmental Constraints - SAC

Known Key Archaeological National Monuments Constraints



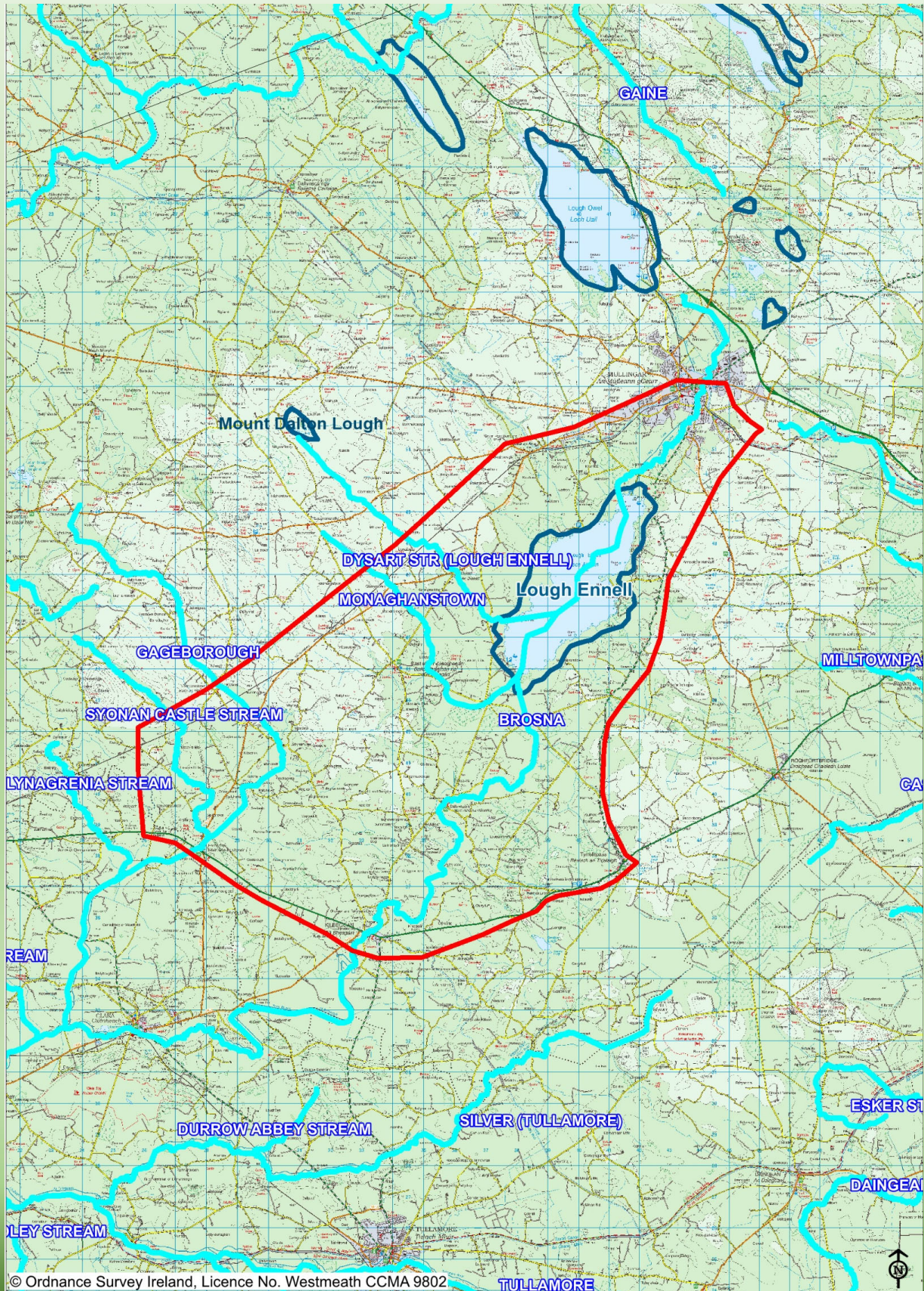

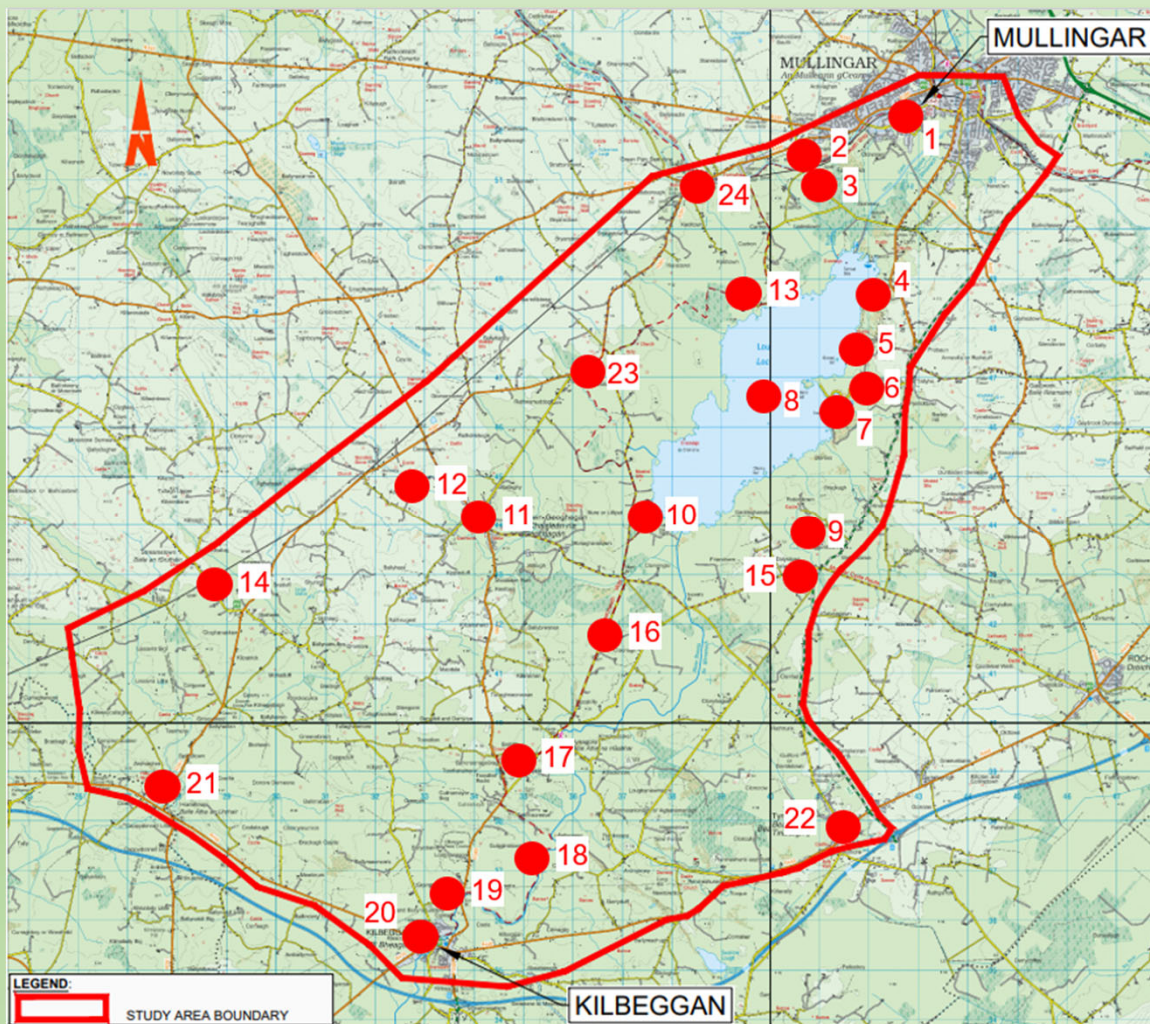

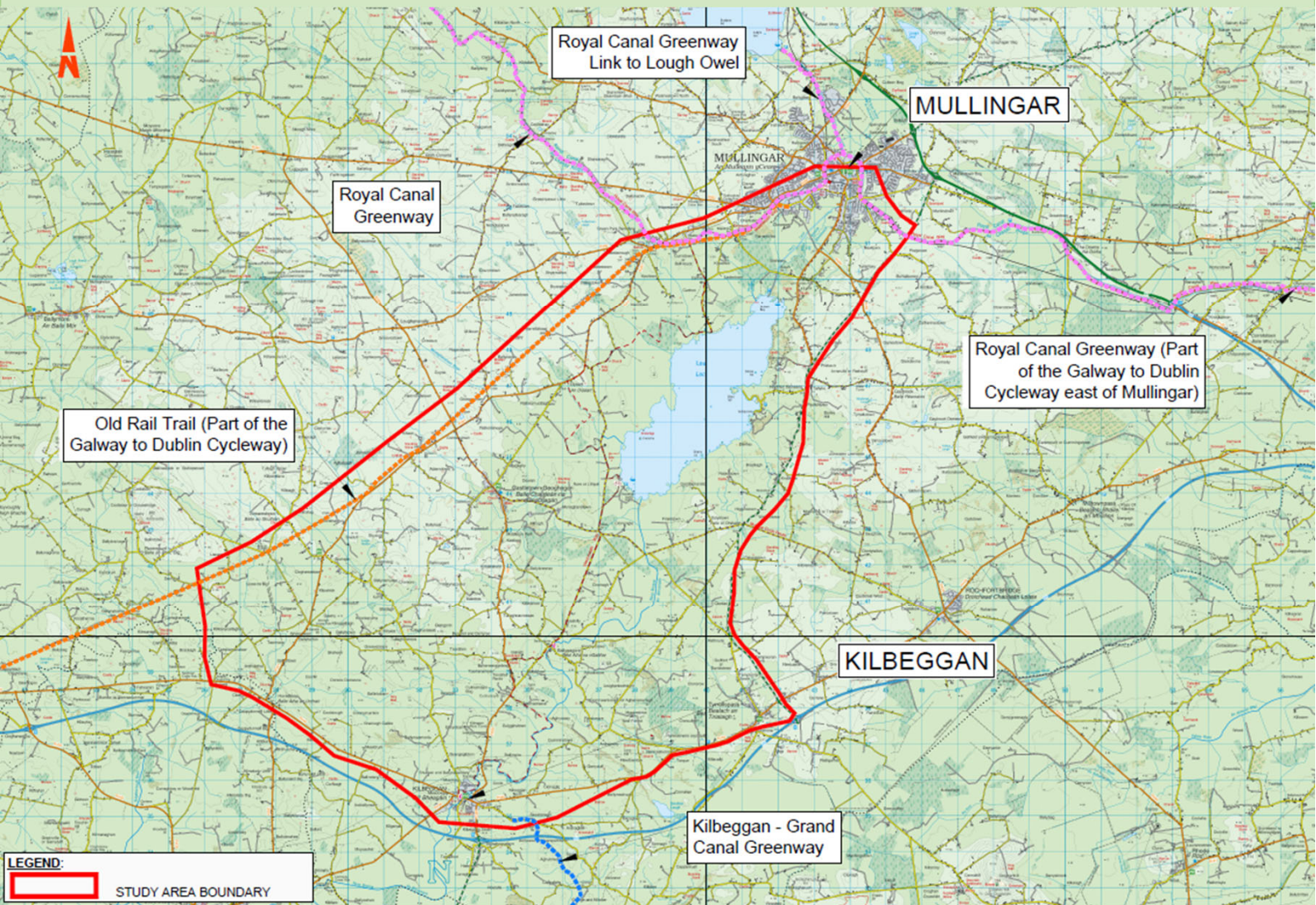
